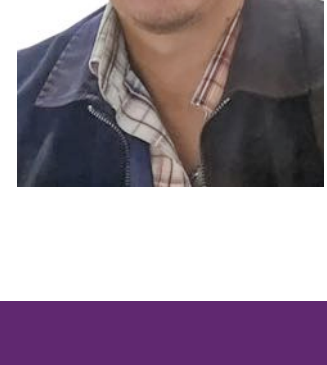

## Spring Is Coming...

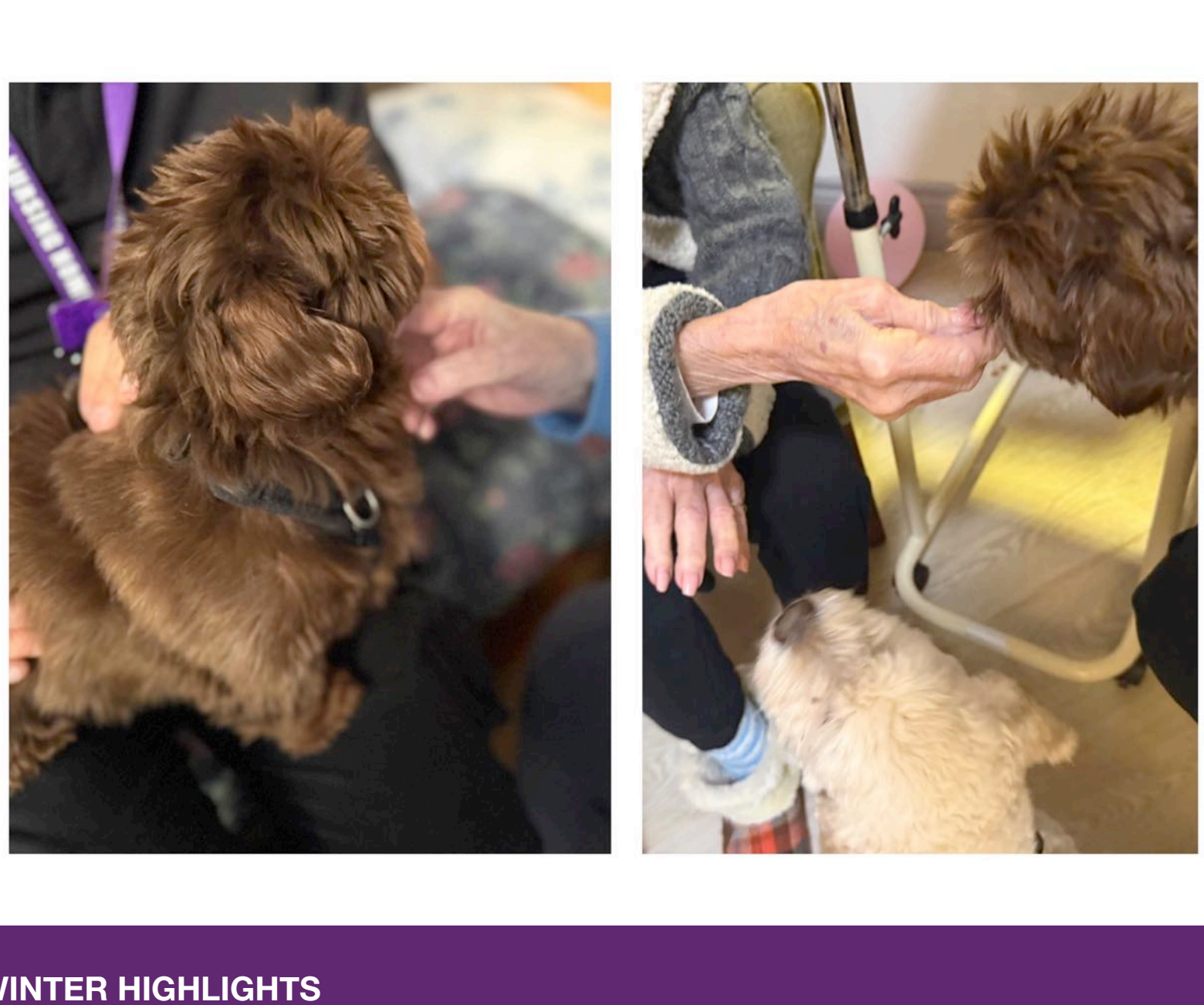
With spring showing signs of new growth, we incorporated a sensory spring trolley for residents to enjoy fresh flowers, fragrances and a cheerful spring themed poem.

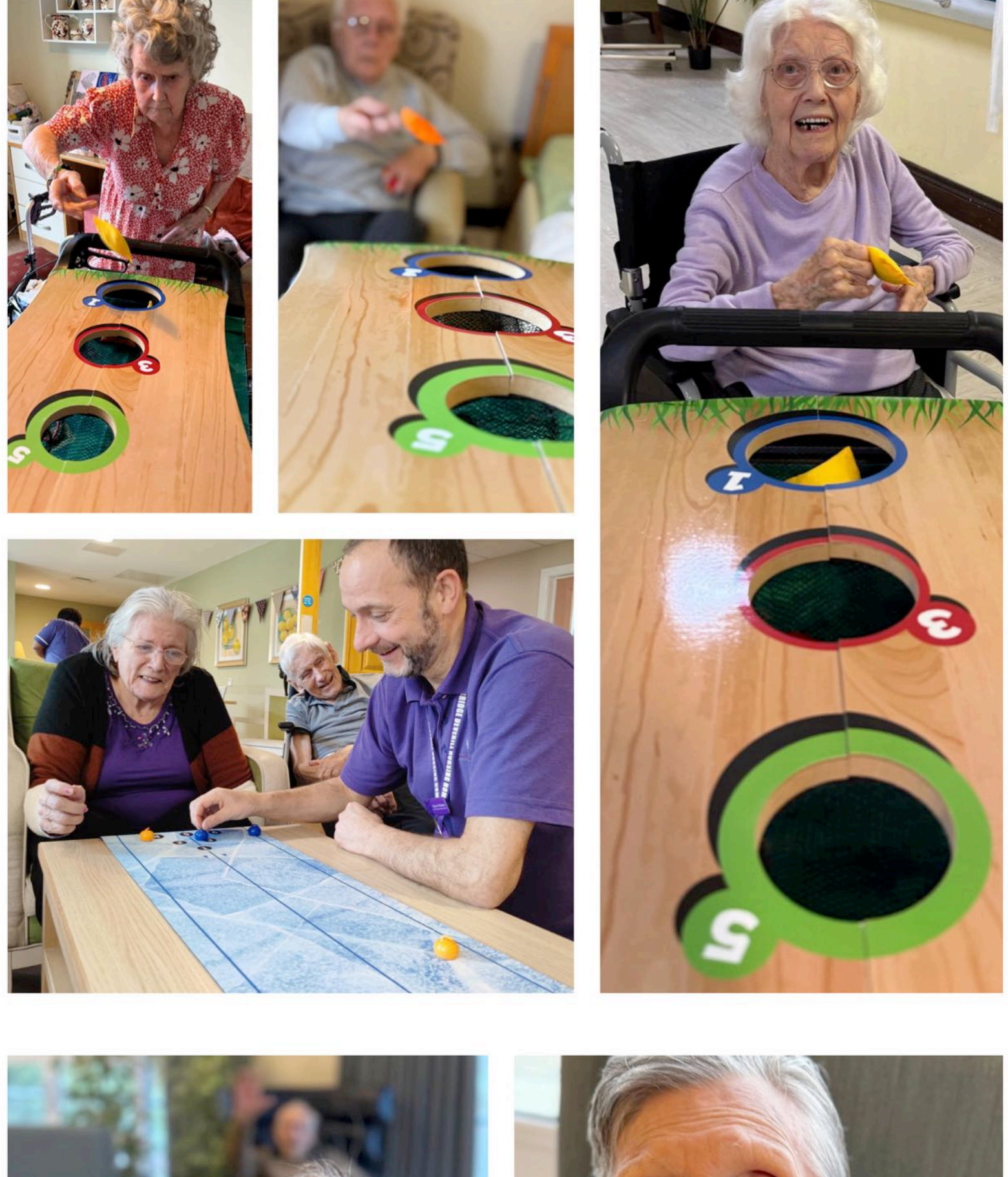
## Cinderella Panto & Sporting Spirit!

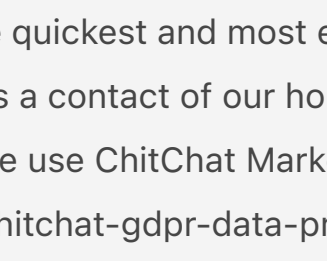
